Induction Loop

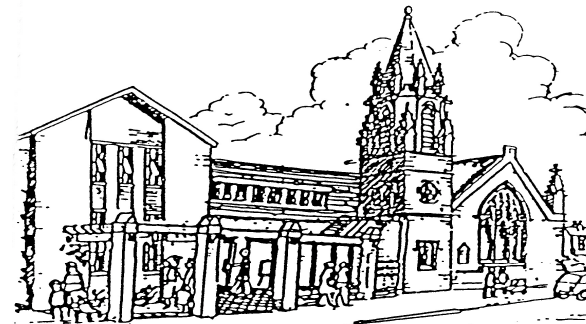
An Induction Loop system for the hard of hearing has been installed in this building. If you wear a hearing aid, to benefit from the system please turn to the "T" position
